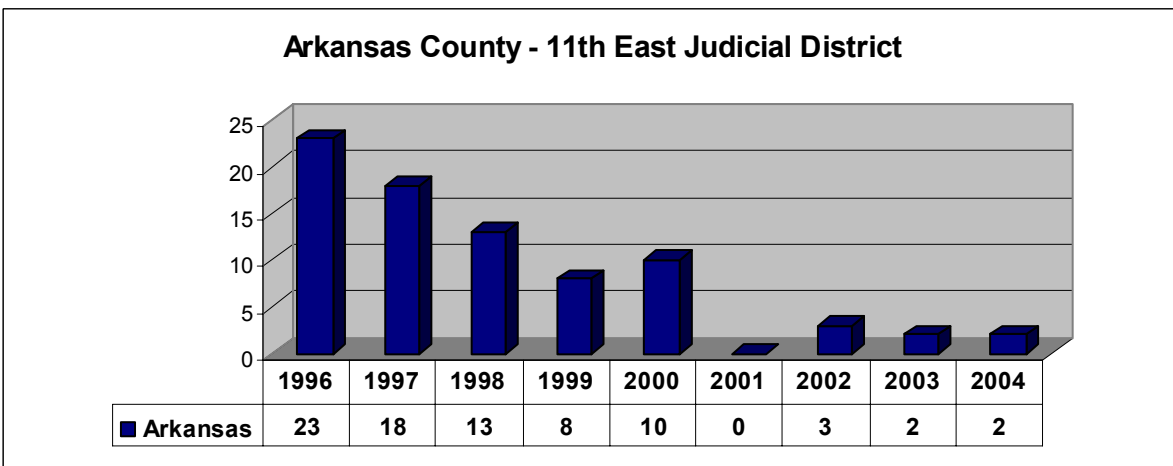


REDUCED COMMITMENT TO THE DIVISION OF YOUTH SERVICES

11th East Judicial District – Arkansas County

With rankings ranging from 24 as high in commitments and 1 as low, the 11th East Judicial District ranked 24 in FY1997. Since UFS begin services in this area there has been a continued reduction in juveniles committed to DYS. In FY1996 there were a total of 23 commitments compared to 2 commitments in FY 2004. This is a **91% overall decrease** in commitments for Arkansas County. *It should be noted in 2001 there were “no” juveniles from Arkansas committed to DYS.*

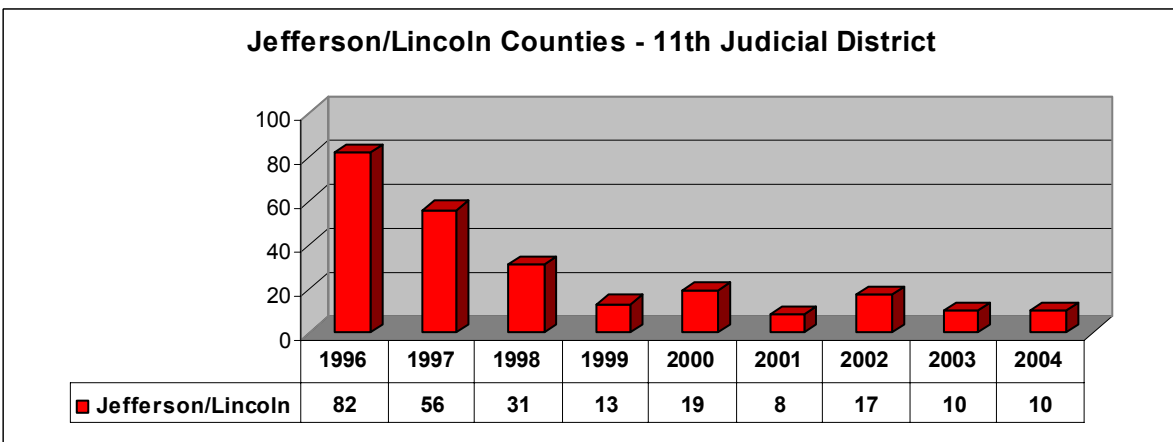
Table #1 – COMMITMENTS



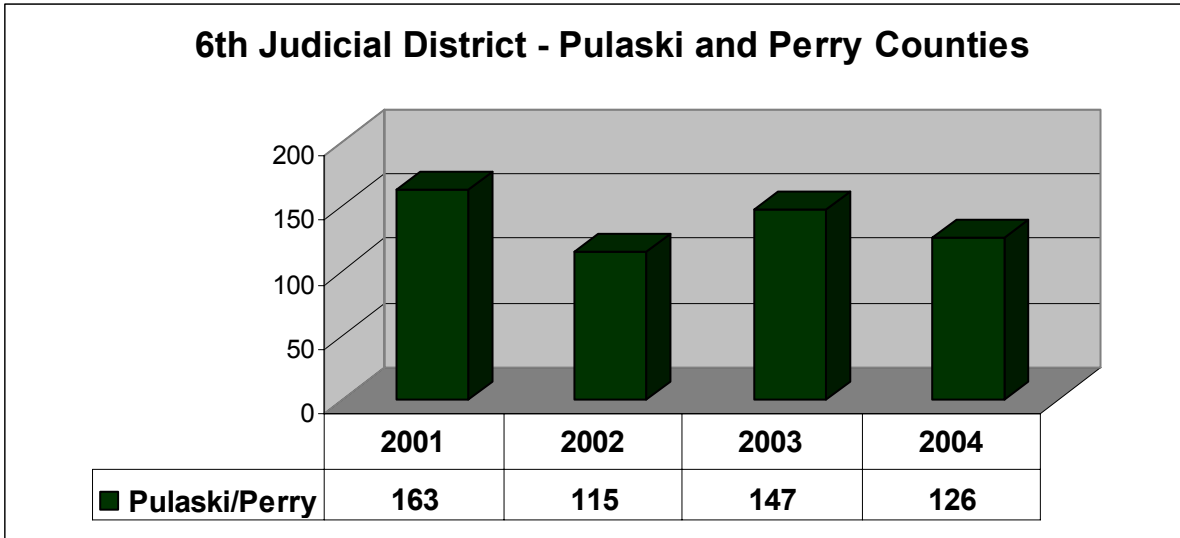
11th West Judicial District – Jefferson and Lincoln Counties

Juvenile commitments from Jefferson and Lincoln counties were among the highest commitments in the state. UFS begin implementing the Comprehensive Treatment Model in 1996, when there were 82 juveniles committed from the 11th Judicial District. In FY 2004 the commitments have been reduced to 10. This is an overall reduction of 88%. Table #2 indicates the annual reductions.

Table #2 – COMMITMENTS

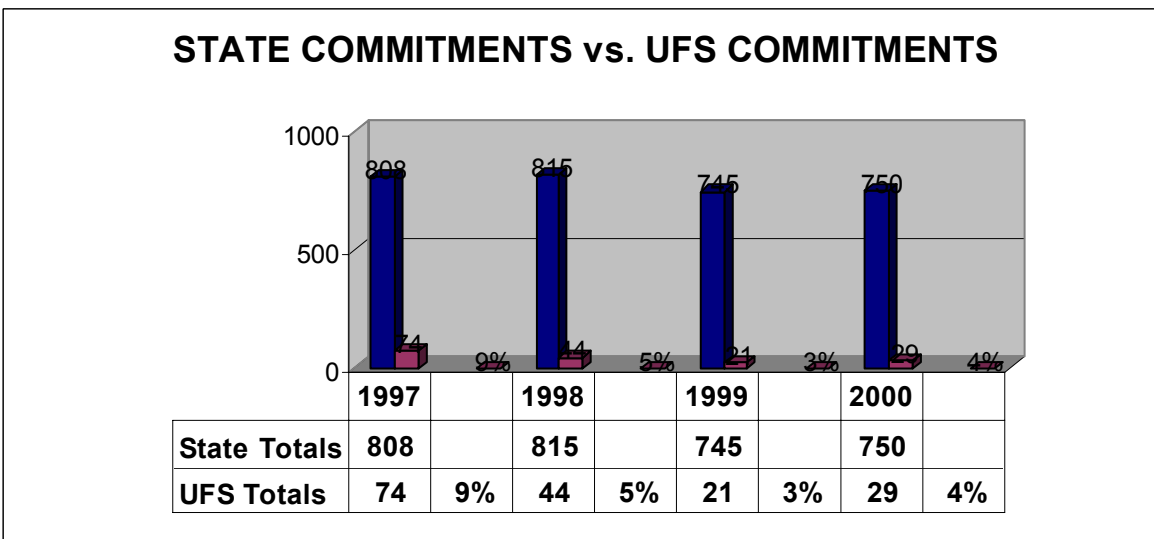


In FY 2001, UFS expanded services to the largest populated county in Arkansas - Pulaski and Perry Counties. Juvenile commitment in FY 2001 was 163. Table #3 reveals that in FY 2004 a total of 126 commitments which is a **reduction of 23%**.



STATEWIDE COMPARISON

A table #4 show from 1997 to 2000 UFS's combined juvenile commitments for the 11th and 11th East Judicial District. In 1997 UFS's service areas had **9% of the total commitments in the state**. **By 2000, UFS had only 4% of the state's total commitments in its service areas.**

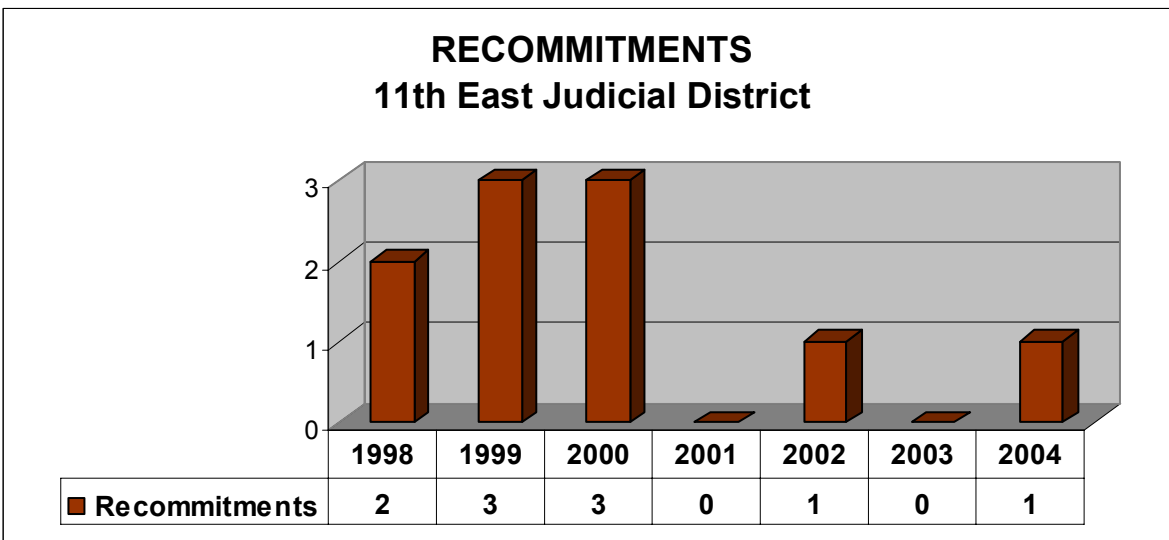
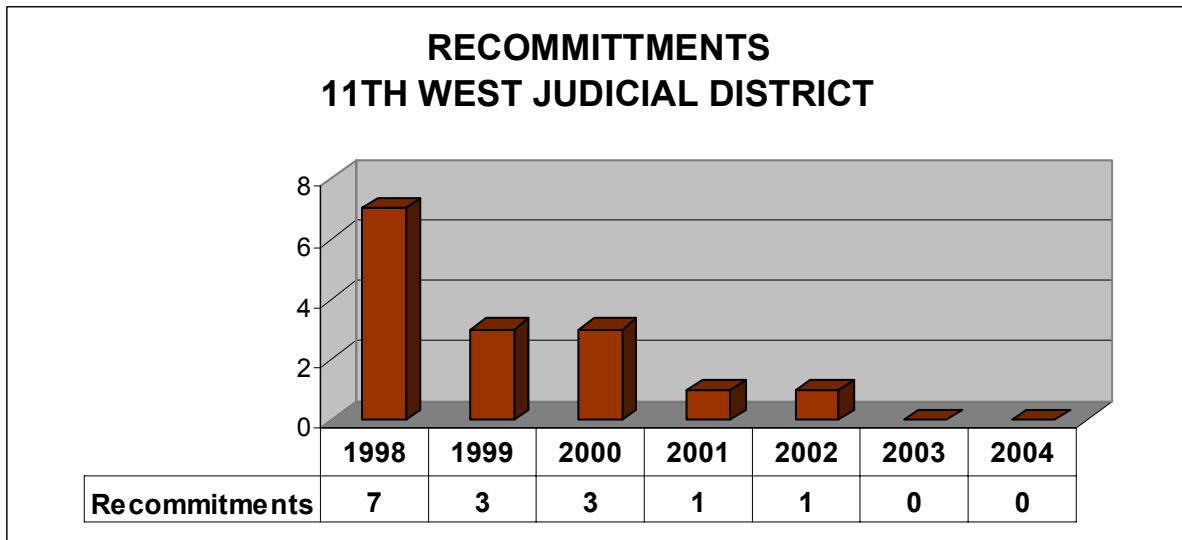


RECOMMITMENTS TO THE DIVISION OF YOUTH SERVICES

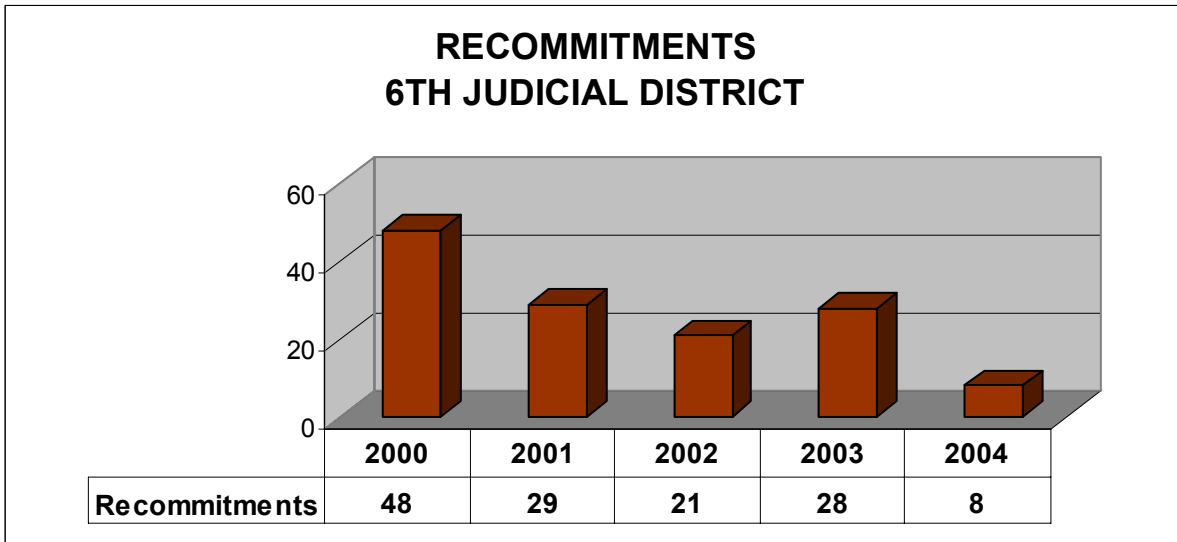
11th East Judicial District – Arkansas County

UFS's Comprehensive Treatment Model reveals its effectiveness through the data shown below. In 1998, there were seven juveniles in the 11th West Judicial District who had been previously committed to DYS and were recommitted. **By 2003 and 2004 there were no recommitments in Jefferson and Lincoln Counties.**

Recommitments in the 11th West Judicial District have been maintained at a low rate. **It should be noted that in 2001 and 2003 there were no recommitments in Arkansas County.**



In the 6th Judicial District UFS has made great strides in reducing the number of juveniles recommitted to the Division of Youth Services. In 2000 there were a total of 48 commitments in Pulaski and Perry counties. However, after the implementation of UFS's Comprehensive Treatment Model in 2001 commitments decreased by 40%. **By 2004, there was an overall reduction of 73% in commitments from 2000.**
